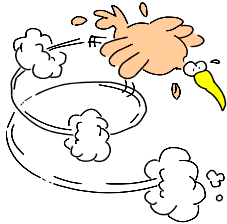


Calvin Can't Fly

Fly This Way!



Cut out the cards below and place them in a stack. In small groups or as a class, draw one card at a time. Some one read the word or phrase written on the card. The group follows the directions on the card as exactly as possible for 15 seconds, remembering to be safe and not too loud.

SWOOP to the north of the room.	SOAR joyfully in a small circle.	TRUDGE forward.
DISCOVER something red in the room.	LINE UP against one wall.	HOVER around your desk.
FLUTTER your right hand.	WADDLE SADLY from your desk to the back of the room.	GRASP a pencil in your left hand.
POINT OUT the south wall in the room.	FLAP your arms as if you were flying. Do not move your feet!	Use your right hand to make LOOP-DE-LOOPS.
DANCE and sing a song	JUMP and FLAP your arms.	SMILE a big wide smile!
