

Objectives: ... represent text in different ways



My Alphabet Picture Book

In The Pirate of Kindergarten, Ginny saw letters and numbers differently from other kids. Look at the letters of the alphabet to discover what pictures you can see in them.

A Class Book

Each student in your class chooses a different letter of the alphabet. On a piece of paper, a student draws a BIG letter and makes it into the picture he or she sees in it. Bind them together in a class book.

An 8-Page Book

Choose your favorite upper case letters or lower case letters to put into an 8-page book. You will need a title page and the seven other pages. Here are some ideas for the seven pages:
